

**Information**  
**on conducting intermediate certification in the form of an exam in the**  
**discipline "Pathological Anatomy, Clinical Pathological Anatomy"**  
**3rd year students of the specialist program 31.05.01 "General Medicine"**

1. Exam venue: clinical base of the Department of the N.N. Blokhin National Medical Research Center of Oncology of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation: Kashirskoye Shosse, 24, building 3, floor 3, room 3, 4.5, 7 (passage: Kashirskaya metro station, the first car from the center, exit to the right).
  2. The exam for each group of students is held strictly according to the schedule of the department.
  3. Students are allowed to take the exam in a white coat and a change of shoes.
  4. It is strictly forbidden to use phones, headphones, smart watches, and other electronic communication devices during the exam.
  5. The form of the exam is oral (by ticket).  
The exam ticket includes:
    - a) theoretical question (on the general or specific course of pathological anatomy)
    - b) practical task: to characterize a microscopic specimen
    - c) practical task: to characterize a macroscopic preparation.  
(the student's survey is like those conducted at the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th colloquiums)
1. The student is given 20 minutes to prepare for the answer on the ticket
  2. Exam grade:

50% theoretical Questions
25 % practical task (microprepare)
25 % practical task (macroprepare)

**THE FINAL GRADE OF STUDENTS IN THE SUBJECT IS FORMED:**  
70% student rating for the first and second semester + 30% exam

Students with a spring semester rating of less than 70% receive the maximum grade of "satisfactory" on the exam
