



## **XIII all-Russian VII International scientific and practical olympiad of students and young scientists on disaster medicine - 2026**

**Dear colleagues!**

We invite You to take part in the XIIIth all -Russian VIIth International scientific and practical olympiad of students and young scientists on disaster medicine 2026, which is holding from March 1st to April 17th, 2026. Address of the organizing institution: Moscow, Ostrovityanova str., 1, RNRMU.

The Olympiad will present the most relevant areas included in the disciplines "life Safety", "Disaster medicine", " Hygiene of emergency situations ", "Emergency Medicine", and also covering technologies for preventing and eliminating natural and man-made emergencies. Students and young scientists (including residents, postgraduates, University employees, and doctors) under the age of 35 are allowed to participate in the scientific and practical competitions of the Olympiad.

**ATTENTION:** To participate in the Olympiad, you should submit completed tasks and/or abstracts and presentations of reports, applications for participation in the practical competition by electronic registration by the specified deadline.

## REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS OF THE OLYMPIAD

Registration of all participants is carried out via the electronic system on the Olympiad page: <https://rsmu.ru/facilities/co/olimpiada-po-medicine-katastrof/>

Registration of foreign citizens for face-to-face participation closes on 03/23/26, for Russian citizens - on 04/12/26. Registration for remote participation closes on 04/17/2026.

After registration, participants can register selectively for contests and sections of the Olympiad.

To work with the registration system for participants of the Olympiad, it is recommended to use web browsers with activated Cookies and JavaScript.

When registering on the site, you must specify the full name of your organization without its status.

### **For instance:**

**Right:** Pirogov Russian National Research Medical University

**Wrong:** FGAOU Russian National Research Medical University named after N.I. Pirogov of the Ministry of Healthcare of the Russian Federation

After registering as a participant, you must go to the desired section or competition and submit your work. Acceptance of works begins on March 1, 2026.

**Attention!** Entrance to the university for full-time participation on April 17, 2026 as a listener, speaker, participant in a practical competition is carried out only upon prior registration with the indication "full-time participation". Registration for face-to-face visits closes 1 month in advance for foreign citizens and 1 week in advance for citizens of the Russian Federation.

## SCIENTIFIC SECTION OF YOUNG SCIENTISTS

**Students and young scientists (including residents, postgraduates, university employees, and doctors) under the age of 35 are allowed to participate in the scientific and practical competitions of the Olympiad.**

**On the Olympiad page, to participate in the section, select "Scientific Section". After registration, it will be able to add a thesis in your personal account and choose the form of participation (in person with a report, publication only).**

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ABSTRACT

An original work that has not been previously published is accepted for the competition. All theses will be checked in the "Anti-Plagiarism" system. Works that have been checked for plagiarism (the uniqueness of at least 85% of the original text) are accepted for publication. Based on the results of the expert jury's evaluation, the papers (theses) will be selected for submission in the form of a full-time report (remotely) and publication in the collection of scientific papers indexed in the RSCI.

Abstracts of no more than 3000 characters should contain sections: relevance, purpose, methods, results and their discussion, conclusions. The papers should correspond to the format of the scientific research. Works of a different format (abstracting articles, essays, research projects or experiments) are not allowed to participate in the competition and publication.

The number of authors should not include persons over 35 years of age and persons already indicated as scientific supervisors (any age) of this scientific work.

## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

To work with the registration system for participants of the Olympiad, it is recommended to use web browsers with activated Cookies and JavaScript.

After registering in the system:

1. Log into the category of "New thesis". **Abstract submission deadline is March 25, 2026.**
2. Select the most appropriate section for your work from the list.
3. Enter the name of your work (the field is not limited by the number of characters and all characters entered in it go to uppercase). The use of abbreviations and abbreviations in the title of theses is not allowed.
4. Fill in the fields for entering the thesis corresponding to the sections: introduction, research purpose, materials and methods, results, conclusions. **The names of the sections will be put down automatically, you do not need to duplicate them in the text.** The total number of characters must be at least 500 and no more than 3000 characters without spaces. It is not allowed to include tables or figures in the abstract.
5. After filling in all the above fields, click "Save" button. Pay attention how the thesis looks like, read it carefully, and correct it if necessary. After the correction, click the "Save" button.
6. Next, you need to go and fill in the sections: organization, authors, speaker, scientific supervisors (at the bottom of the page after the text of the theses). After entering the information in each of the sections, you need to click the "Save" button.
7. Section "Authors": here you must specify the full name of all the authors of the work, as well as correlate the authors and affiliated organizations.
8. Section "Scientific supervisors": specify the full name of the scientific supervisors, then the scientific degree and scientific title abbreviated.
9. After filling in all the above fields, the "Submit" button will appear. **Carefully review all the entered information again.** Until you click the "Submit" button, the thesis is in the draft stage, and you can make changes at any time. After clicking the "Submit" button, the abstract will go to the "Applications" section and will be closed for correction.
10. After submitting the thesis, we ask you to regularly visit your personal account, and check for comments from the curators of the section regarding the coordination of technical edits in the thesis and administrative issues. In case of a large number of typos and incorrectly entered information, the thesis will be removed from consideration. After completion, it can be uploaded as a new application.

The selection of works for full-time participation (remotely) and publication will be carried out by the competent Expert Commission. All abstracts will be submitted to the experts only after passing the depersonalization procedure.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF THE REPORT AND PRESENTATION FOR THE COMPETITION

A full-time report of 7 minutes (remotely via a video conference platform). Recommendations for preparing the presentation of the report for the competition: it is provided in the form of a PowerPoint presentation of 5-10 slides with a volume of up to 10 MB. It is possible to include the author's photographs.

On the first slide, specify the title of the work, the name and initials of the author (co-authors are separated by commas, no more than three) and the supervisor, the name of the organization in which the author works, the city, and the country.

Reports and presentations should be built according to the standard scheme and contain sections: relevance, purpose, material and methods of research, results and their discussion, conclusions.

Recommended distribution of information on the slides: relevance-1-2 slides, the purpose of the study-1 slide, material and methods-1-2 slides, results-3-4 slides, discussion-1 slide, conclusions-1 slide.

All borrowed materials, including photos and videos, must be accompanied by a link to the source.

Presentations of the selected for the oral presentation works should be sent to the organizing committee **no later than April 12, 2026** to [disastermed.rsmu@ya.ru](mailto:disastermed.rsmu@ya.ru) with a mandatory note in the subject of the letter "Olympiad in Disaster Medicine, presentation of the author's FULL NAME".

According to the results of the scientific section, the winners in the categories "Best Report" and "Best Thesis" will be announced.

## THEORETICAL COMPETITION

**Students of specialized educational institutions are allowed to participate in the theoretical competition. The competition involves individual participation.**

On the Olympiad page, to participate in the theoretical competition, you must select "Theoretical Competition". The competition is held remotely online.

After registration, participants will have access to the 1<sup>st</sup> tour of contest tasks. Answers to tasks are accepted **from March 1 to March 15, 2026**. The competition involves a one-time participation, completing tasks on time. Responses from re-registered participants are not allowed to the contest.

Participants who have scored at least 30% of correct answers in the competition will receive certificates of participation.

Participants with 80% or more correct answers are invited to the second stage of the competition from March 20 to 30. According to the results of the second stage, the winners and winners of the theoretical competition will be determined.

## PRACTICAL COMPETITION

**Students of specialized educational institutions are allowed to participate in the practical competition. The competition involves the participation of a team of 1-3 people. Participants can only be part of one team; otherwise both teams will be removed from the competition.**

On the Olympiad page, to participate in the competition, you must select "Practical Competition". The competition is held in two stages, the first stage is remote, the second is full-time.

After registration, participants will have access to the contest tasks. The solution of the task (video demonstration) must be sent **from March 1 to March 25, 2026.**

**Video response requirements:** The answer to the competitive task in a video format lasting no more than 3 minutes should be posted on the video hosting RuTube.com or a other with link access (attention: open access to the video is not recommended, as the video may contain inaccurate or erroneous information). The video should contain the inscription "Practical competition, Olympiad in disaster Medicine 2026" and the full name of the team members. Before sending a link to the contest, make sure that the link is working.

## COMPETITION «FIRST AID»

**Students, students of specialized classes, teachers are allowed to participate in the practical competition. The competition involves the participation of a team of 1-3 people. Participants can only be part of one team, otherwise both teams will be removed from the competition.**

On the Olympiad page, to participate in the "First Aid" contest, select "First Aid Contest". The competition is held remotely.

After registration, participants will have access to the contest tasks. The task solution (video demonstration) must be sent **from March 1 to March 25, 2026.**

**Video response requirements:** The answer to the competitive task in a video format lasting no more than 3 minutes should be posted on the video hosting RuTube.com or a other with link access (attention: open access to the video is not recommended, as the video may contain inaccurate or erroneous information). The video should contain the inscription "First Aid Contest, Olympiad in Disaster Medicine 2026" and the full name of the team members. Before sending a link to the contest, make sure that the link is working.

## COMPETITION «YOUNG TEACHER»

**Employees of departments of universities and colleges, teachers, as well as graduate students under 35 years of age are allowed to participate in the competition.**

The competition involves individual participation, conducted remotely.

On the Olympiad page, to participate in the competition, you must select the "Young Teacher Competition". The competition is held remotely.

After registration, participants will have access to the contest tasks. The solution of the task must be sent **from March 1 to March 26, 2025.**

**Requirements for the answer:** The answer to the competition task in PDF format should be placed on Yandex Disk or another with access by link. The work must contain the full name of the participant, place of work, position, then the text of the answer (no more than 5 pages). Before sending a link to the contest, make sure that the link is working.
